

About Us 55th Season (2022-23)

Orchestra:

Founded in 1967, we are **Oakville's largest orchestra** with 85 musicians. Ten are professionals, several are Young Artist Award-winners, and the rest are committed amateurs. Two original members still play with the orchestra, including Jean Grieve, founder of the Oakville Suzuki Association. Outstanding guest soloists perform at each concert.

Concerts:

Each year, Oakville Symphony performs eight subscription concerts and two Family Christmas concerts at the **Oakville Centre for the Performing Arts**, which seats 496 patrons.. Read a concert review.

Community outreach:

Pre-Covid, we engaged 780 children through mini-concerts in the lobby of the Oakville Centre, school visits with the Oakville Community Foundation's *Community Classroom* program, and outreach events at Kerr St Mission. Small groups of musicians performed at the hospital and retirement residences, and our Maestro presented his *Not Just the Score* talks at venues such as the Oakville Club.

Covid-19:

During the pandemic, **we took music online**. We developed a <u>Virtual Recital Series</u> with solo performances by our professional musicians and guests, and artist chats. Our musicians recorded presentations from home for OCF's <u>Online Community Classroom</u> and our regular mini-concert attendees. We featured local businesses and Town Councillors in a Twelve Days of Christmas video, and we shared a Musician Spotlight series on our website and social media. On returning to in-person concerts in 2021-22, we offered a livestream option.
